BEENTHRUTHEDESERT, in touch between rivals, closed six-wide into the stretch, responded smartly and swept by the pacesetter midstretch and finished in hand. NAJRAN'S PICK raced off the pace, angled nine-wide late turn and rallied willingly outside. MUSKWA forced the pace in hand, bid early turn, dueled, gained command at the top of the stretch, failed to maintain the lead near the 16th pole but finished gamely. RED AND BOLD, in range outside, angled from four-wide to seven-wide on the turn and finished willingly. KING CAYENNE, well back early, was hustled on the turn, came eight-wide to the top of the stretch and finished determinedly. J T MORGAN raced well back, angled from three to nine-wide on the turn but never reached contention. RED LAKE GOLD showed brief speed, stalked the pace on the turn then lacked a late response. TUSCAN MIST, well back early, was hustled along the rail on the turn then finished gamely between horses but did not threaten. FERNBROOK showed speed, dueled on the turn, was headed at the top of the stretch, chased, then tired late. JOEY D., in touch between rivals, raced three and four-wide on the turn then evened out in the stretch. CIANO NIGHTS raced midpack, was hustled from four to eight-wide on the turn but tired in the final furlong. CRAFTY BREEZE raced midpack, angled from the rail to four-wide on the turn then lacked a rally. SYMPHONY OF FIRE, in touch, saved ground but tired in the stretch. LEAVE YOUR MARK, in touch between foes, chased on the turn then tired in the stretch.
