HALO BRAVE raced off the pace, closed then bid midturn, drove to the lead at the top of the stretch, was quickly engaged, dueled in the final furlong and prevailed under a drive. CUVARA stalked the pace, closed then bid late turn, was headed at the top of the stretch, rebid in the final furlong and was very game but was outfinished. OUR WISH raced off the pace, chased late turn, came six-wide to the top of the stretch and finished determinedly. KATHLEENS A CATCH settled off the pace, chased five-wide on the far turn then evened out in the late stages. PENTHOUSE VIEW raced off the pace, was hustled five then four-wide on the far turn but never reached contention. I'M IN CHARGE stalked the pace, his saddle slipped early turn, took command early backstretch, vied late turn and tired at the head of the stretch. TIME FOR THE STARS set a reserved pace to the backstretch, was headed, stalked to late turn and tired.
