FLASH CRASH, steadied at the start, settled off the pace, closed three-wide on the turn, split foes upper stretch then rallied and got by the leader late, driving. SOLO PLAYER pressed the pace, bid late backstretch, shook clear on the turn, was all out in the stretch but failed to hold. SPECIAL SELECTION stalked the pace, was set down upper stretch, chased gamely but was unable to show a gain. ROCKY ROMANO settled off the pace, chased six-wide late turn and finished determinedly. SAMURAI SLAM, bumped at the outset, settled off the pace, angled four to six-wide late turn then finished gamely outside rivals. BE A BULL, up close on the backstretch, forced the pace into the turn, chased to the stretch then flattened out in the stretch. SUNDIN raced in midpack, gained striking range late turn, chased two-wide into the stretch then evened out in the late stages. FOUR ONE SIX, in range, chased four-wide on the turn then evened out in the final 16th. GOT YOU COVERED, in range, chased hard six-wide late turn then evened out midstretch. HAD TO HAPPEN broke outward and bumped a rival, raced off the pace, saved ground but never reached contention. THE BEAR VOW raced off the pace, was hustled angling out on the turn, chased five-wide into the stretch but failed to menace. HE'S ETAIN settled off the pace, was hustled five-wide late turn then lacked a closing response. MONO CLIFFS pressed the pace to the turn, backed away and lacked a closing response. DERAILED led quickly, set a pressured pace, was headed near the turn and faded to the outside.
