HAUTE CUISINE forced the pace to the backstretch, assumed a short lead, moved clear nearing the turn and widened through the stretch under a hand ride. QUEENLY LUCK rated early, closed on the rail through the far turn but could not gain in the stretch. DIXIELAND GEM stalked four-wide on the first turn and three-wide on the backstretch, chased on the far turn but evened out in the stretch. HIGHER APPROVAL stalked three-wide on the clubhouse turn, chased on the far turn then flattened out in the stretch. COFFEE TIME rated early, saved ground then lacked a late response. CHINA RAIN led early, was under pressure through the first turn, yielded early on the backstretch and faded.
