FINANCINGAVAILABLE raced off the pace between horses, closed leaving the turn, rallied willingly and got up late, driving. HATPIN forced the pace, took the lead midturn, shook clear at the top of the stretch, was all out but failed to hold. ROVING ANGEL closed four-wide late turn, bid midstretch, battled all out and missed. COUNT TO THREE stalked three-wide, chased into the stretch, was all out but hung late. SUDSY BABY raced off the pace between foes and finished all out. MISS CONCERTO, well back between foes, angled five-wide at the top of the stretch and rallied mildly. BOSSKIRI stalked along the rail, was hustled along the second path late turn but flattened out in the stretch. ELLE RUNAWAY raced off the pace, closed five-wide late turn then flattened out. CULPEPER MOON, well back early, saved ground, was roused late turn but showed no response. COASTAL FORTRESS raced off the pace along the second path, lacked a closing response. SHOT GUN ELA led early, set a pressured pace, was headed midturn, chased to the top of the stretch and tired.
