SEPTEMBER SQUARE broke in the air and settled off the pace, closed on the far turn, was blocked near the top of the stretch, rallied between foes, angled to the rail in the late stages and was up just in time, driving. FORTY CREEK stalked the pace, dueled from the rail through the far turn, moved clear into the stretch then failed to hold in deep stretch. BULLONTHEWIRE raced off the pace, closed three to five-wide on the far turn then rallied late outside. MICHAEL'S BAD BOY, in touch, chased four-wide on the far turn but evened out in deep stretch. LANGFUHR COUNTRY, in touch, was hustled four and five-wide on the far turn but evened out in the late stages. JEBSTER, off slowly, stalked the pace, chased along the rail late turn then evened out in deep stretch. SKIP CODE, in touch between rivals, was blocked late turn then finished evenly when clear. MAPLE TINTS raced in midpack, was hustled three-wide late turn but lacked a closing response. PRINCE RAFFIE, rated early, raced well off the pace and was never in contention. MIGHTY MONARCH pressed the pace, bid early backstretch, dueled, was headed midturn, chased briefly and tired. POINT TUPPER led early, dueled on the backstretch, gave way midturn, chased to the stretch and tired.
