CHRIS'S BAD BOY led quickly, was joined in a duel by DREAM LAUNCHER early backstretch, dueled to the turn and drew clear, widened leaving the turn and was kept to business through the stretch. MINISTERS WILD CAT closed three-wide late turn then rallied gamely through the stretch. DREAM LAUNCHER bid early on the backstretch, dueled to the turn then chased to the stretch but evened out in the late stages. FANTASTIC DAY stalked the pace from between foes but lacked a stretch response. TWISTED WIT chased hard along the rail through the turn then tired in the final furlong. SAINT APPEAL well back on the rail, lacked a rally. DILLINGER always far back, lacked a closing response.
