Footnotes

SEASIDE VIEW, off a step slowly, was unhurried early,angled out closing on the far turn, came seven-wide into the stretch,rallied, got up midstretch and outfinished LA BONITA UNO under a light drive. LA BONITA UNO set a reserved pace, was headed early on the backstretch, chased on the far turn, finished gamely but was outkicked in the late stages. BLACK MINK, close early, took command early on the backstretch, set the pace, was collared a sixteenth out and weakened. JETEYE, in range between rivals, was hustled on the far turn and finished all out. VICTORIA BAY, in range early, was hustled along the rail and angled six-wide late turn but tired at the top of the stretch. SHELF was unhurried early, closed along the rail on the far turn but never reached contention. RAWSON'S RETREAT, in range to midway through the backstretch, came four-wide through the far turn but did not threaten. KINISHA stalked early, dropped back late backstretch and lacked a late response.
