VILLAGE DRIVE gained a short early lead, set a reserved pace, was pressured into the far turn and entertained challenges late turn, shook clear at the top of the stretch and widened under a drive. MUDDER AT THE BAR raced off the pace, was hustled on the far turn, rallied five-wide and was all out to the end. BOOGIE BLUES stalked the pace, bid late turn, was headed at the top of the stretch but finished all out. DISCLOSURE hopped a bit at the start and settled off the pace, chased through the far turn, swung out approaching the stretch and tendered a mild rally. NAFTA stalked early then moved closer and forced the pace on the turn, bid between foes late turn but was headed at the top of the stretch, chased briefly then tired a 16th out. HEY BATTER BATTER, rated midpack between foes, was roused upper stretch but showed no serious response. ESPORON settled on the first turn, was hustled along the rail on the far turn then flattened out in the stretch. BULLET BOY stalked the pace, chased into the stretch but came up empty when asked.
