TIERRA DEL TIGRE had speed to lead into the first turn, was clear of rivals and holding sway from off the rail then held command to the wire while being kept to task. MONTANA MEMORIES chased the speed and kept contact into the stretch from the six path then kept it going and held the place over a group of rivals. PIT ALLEY had an outside trip, bid from the six path in the drive and finished off a good effort. VEGAS WEEKEND had an inside trip, was in striking distance the bid inside in the drive only to be outgunned to the wire. RED LEADER on the inside early, angled out to bid from the five path but lacked a serious kick. FREE TO FLY raced in mid pack and off the rail then had no finish. STARDUST ZIGGY trailed early, was widest into the stretch then bid failed to impact.
