ROYAL DALLIANCE was slow early and trailed in the field, rallied on the turn while saving ground, edged off the rail at the quarter pole, but was blocked briefly, assumed command with less than a furlong to go and drew clear under intermittent urging. EMILYNA stalked the early pace just off the rail, closed the gap three wide on the turn, assumed command in the drive, but was no match for the winner. BOLD ENGAGEMENT was unhurried early just off the rail, roused widest on the turn and rallied belatedly. LITE IN THE NIGHT stalked the early pace along the rail and was in steadied approaching the far turn, closed the gap again, but was blocked entering the stretch and checked, then came up empty in the drive. TOPSY MORNING (IRE) was away alertly and set a pressured pace outside of rivals, drew clear on the turn, then tired in the drive. REGALCLASS was allowed to settle outside of rivals, roused four wide on the turn, but never rallied and was never a threat. ETERNALLY YOURS was unhurried early, made a mild bid three wide on the turn, but flattened out and was never a threat. CLEOCATRA was hustled along pressing the early pace inside of rivals, then faded in the stretch.
