BALLEN ISLE stalked the pace, closed three-wide on the turn, bid at the top of the stretch, moved clear quickly and prevailed under a light drive. PORTS N PORSCHEs closed between foes into the turn, chased two-wide and finished gamely in vain. DAKOTA FREEWAY raced midpack, angled out four-wide closing on the turn and was all out through the stretch. SILVER PEARL raced off the pace, came five-wide late turn and launched a determined rally. CANADIAN MUSIC stalked four-wide, chased late turn then evened out in the stretch. BIRDIE BOBBY B broke alertly then settled, raced four and five-wide on the turn then rallied belatedly. ANOTHER ASCOT closed between foes late backstretch, chased on the turn then flattened out. CHEMISTRY CLASS stalked the pace, chased along the rail on the turn but tired in the final furlong. LIGHT OF GOLD raced midpack along the rail but never reached contention. VERY PROFESSIONAL, close early, dropped back four-wide on the turn and lacked a rally. TOUCH OF QUALITY, well back early, lacked a closing response. BLUSHING BARON was hustled early, took the lead on the backstretch, set the pace but tired at the top of the stretch.
