SPUNKY stalked the pace, was hustled four-wide late turn, rallied and came out a bit midstretch but got up late under a drive. STEP LIGHTLY broke outward, raced off the pace, closed six-wide late turn and rallied willingly outside. ARGUIDOS sprinted clear, set the pace along the rail, was tiring midstretch and failed to stay. MOREISEELESSIKNOW, close early, was steadied midway of the backstretch, came three-wide late turn, was blocked at the top of the stretch, found a path and finished all out. CAOUTCHOUC broke outward, was hustled late turn, lost her path midstretch and evened out. NICE LADY, in range, was patient behind rivals on the rail late turn but flattened out in the final furlong. HEREISTHERING pressed the pacesetter early, chased two-wide on the turn and tired in the stretch. NINE MIRACLES pressed early between rivals, chased three-wide late turn then tired in the stretch.
