CACTUS PARK raced off the pace, was hustled along the rail, gained in the stretch then moved off the rail in deep stretch and surged to the front under a drive. SKIP THE NIGHT raced off the pace, was hustled three-wide to five-wide late turn and rallied gamely through the stretch. BOB N WEAVE closed four-wide on the turn, gained steadily in the stretch but needed a bit more in the late stages. COWBOY'S DREAM forced the pace from the inside, bid upper stretch and drove clear but failed to stay. WHERE'S THE SUN, off a step slowly, raced three-wide on the turn, altered course upper stretch and rallied late between horses. SEQUIN, off a step slowly, was hustled four and five-wide on the turn then tendered a mild rally outside. SPARKLING MICAYLA was hustled to a short lead, raced clear through the turn then gave way when engaged upper stretch. PRECIOUS SURPRISE chased along the rail and tired in the final furlong. SHEKINA WEST raced midpack along the rail, was hustled along, moved between horses at the top of the stretch but evened out. GETTING BOLD was close early then settled in range, was hustled three-wide on the turn then tired in the final furlong. DREAM CRUSADER, well back early, saved ground but never reached contention. DIAMOND SWEET was hustled along three-wide then tired in the final furlong.
