Footnotes

BRALORNE had brief speed then pressed the pace, bid upper stretch, dueled to the wire and prevailed, driving. POWERMOUSE had early speed, shook clear into the far turn, set a pressured pace, was engaged upper stretch, dueled to the end and missed. TAIERI RIVER, in touch, chased four and five-wide on the far turn, was determined in the stretch but just missed. PERFECT CHEROKEE raced midpack, was hustled five-wide late turn then finished gamely but evenly. RULES OF HONOR stalked the pace, was hustled two and three-wide on the far turn then evened out midstretch. SIR ADIE, rated off the pace, angled from the third path to six-wide closing late turn then finished gamely in vain. VIKINGER (IRE) raced midpack, chased six-wide on the far turn, was hustled into the stretch then evened out late. RUN A BUCK raced midpack early then settled off the pace, was set down upper stretch but was never a threat. PROMISING DANCER, well back early, was hustled angling from four to six-wide on the far turn but never reached contention. ROMAN GAMES raced off the pace, was hustled five-wide on the far turn then flattened out midstretch. BUDDHA MASTER, well back early, closed on the backstretch, was hustled seven-wide on the turn and failed to menace. SUMMANUS raced off the pace, was hustled four-wide through the far turn then lacked a rally. SIN OF OMISSION had brief speed then stalked the pace to late turn and tired.
