RUBY'S MINE set a pressured pace, shook clear early turn then held sway under steady encouragement through the stretch. SIXTY FOUR MODEL stalked the pace, chased two-wide late turn and finished gamely in vain. DIAMONDS FOR MIA settled off the pace, was hustled three and four-wide on the turn then gamely and was just up for third. PASSIONISTA pressed the pace on the backstretch, chased four-wide on the turn then evened out in the stretch. RING OF LUCK stalked early then backed away on the turn, was hustled along but lacked a serious rally. K BE KATIE forced the issue, backed away on the turn, was roused at the top of the stretch but showed no response.
