Footnotes

FREEDOM COME pressed the early pace from the outside, assumed command on the turn, then drew clear in the stretch under steady pressure. RUBY TANGO stalked the early pace between horses and finished well. CHAMUL was void of early speed outside of rivals, roused five wide on the turn and closed willingly. TOWER OF HONOUR was hustled along four wide and finished evenly. CLAIRLYN was void of early speed, roused between horses on the turn and made a mild bid, but was never a threat. BRIDE IN THE WINGS set the early pace in hand inside of rivals, then tired in the stretch and dropped back. FAR AND NEAR was unhurried early between horses and never a threat. SIMPLY PRECIOUS was void of early speed and never a threat. CLASSIC GRATA pressed the early pace between horses, then tired in the stretch. LADY GINA ROSA was hustled along inside of rivals, then dropped back on the turn.
