Footnotes

GOSPEL GRINDER raced off the pace along the rail, closed into the far turn, bid late turn along with GOLD SPINNER, shook clear at the top of the stretch and held sway under a strong hand ride. FEET ON FIRE raced well off the early pace, closed on the far turn, was set down at the top of the stretch and rallied gamely. GOLD SPINNER stalked from between horses, bid late turn, was headed at the top of the stretch, chased briefly and tired. SONJABELLA raced off the pace, chased hard four-wide on the far turn, came six-wide into the stretch and evened out. QUEEN OF ALL CATS stalked from the inside, chased two then three-wide late turn but flattened out in the final furlong. I AIN'T NO QUITTER raced off the pace between rivals, was two-wide on the far turn, was hustled into the stretch then flattened out. SWEET THEATRICAL sprinted to the early lead, was joined late on the first turn, dueled to the far turn and moved clear, was headed late turn and tired. PETERSHILL, well back early, saved ground on the far turn then lacked a strong late response. SOUTHERN RELATIONS stalked three then four-wide, gave way late backstretch and faded. SPLASH OF GOLD, off a step slowly, raced off the pace, was hustled four then five-wide on the far turn but tired in the stretch. C'MON SURPRISE ME chased the leader into the first turn, bid late turn, dueled through the backstretch then gave away early on the final turn and tired.
