Footnotes

PARABOLA, rated early and still well back on the far turn, was blocked late turn, angled out at the top of the stretch, rallied smartly and got up late under a drive. MEAN GREEN stalked three-wide, chased into the stretch, bid a sixteenth out but was outfinished. WILDCAT FASHION showed early speed in hand, dueled on the backstretch and far turn, drove clear upper stretch then weakened in the final sixteenth. FLIP FOR THE COIN, off a step slowly, stalked from between rivals, was hustled into the stretch and finished determinedly. KEEP SIX raced off the pace, was hustled five-wide into the stretch and finished all out. HISAKI, in range, was roused three-wide midturn, encountered a bit of traffic in the stretch and evened out. MENSCH, well back early, was hustled on the far turn, angled off approaching the stretch but never reached contention. ISZATSO under strong rating up close on the first turn, stalked on the backstretch, saved ground on the turn and evened out in the stretch. SHUT IT DOWN, five-wide into the first turn, bid early backstretch, dueled to the top of

the stretch and tired. ME THE SEA AND G T raced off the pace along the rail, was contentious between foes on the far turn, was blocked upper stretch then flattened out in the final furlong. COLLEROSA closed along the rail on the backstretch, raced on the fringes on the far turn then tired in the final furlong.
