GENERAL BROCK, in range, closed six-wide late turn, rallied and got by SHABAAB in deep stretch under a drive. SHABAAB showed brief speed, was quickly headed and forced the pace, challenged past midturn, had command at the top of the stretch, was all out but failed to hold the winner safe. COME ON LOVE, rated in range, angled from two to seven-wide on the turn then rallied from last at the top of the stretch. EXCHANGE NOTE stalked from between horses, closed three-wide into the stretch and finished determinedly inside. VENOM stalked four-wide, chased hard five-wide late turn, was game but evened out late. PAYNES GOLD, in range, chased four-wide into the stretch then rallied mildly. VEGAS WEEKEND, in touch along the rail, launched an all out bid upper stretch but failed to get up and tired. WINN CREEK set a pressured pace, was engaged just past midturn, dueled, yielded near the top of the stretch and tired.
