Footnotes

PERFECT STUDENT vied briefly, moved clear midway through the backstretch, set the pace then held sway under a hand ride. PHINEAS raced off the pace, closed six-wide late turn then rallied between horses. I'LL BUY raced midpack, angled five-wide late turn then rallied late outside. CHIEF SOMERSET, off a step slowly, was hustled three to seven-wide on the turn but lacked the necessary rally. MIGHTY MONARCH raced off the pace, closed four to six-wide on the turn, chased through the stretch then evened out late. SIR HEART THROB broke alertly, settled in range, chased hard late turn but

evened out in deep stretch. KWIK COSTA raced midpack two-wide, chased late turn then flattened out in the stretch. EDDIE ZANETTI dropped well off the pace, was hustled on the turn but never reached contention. FEDERAL COURT, off a step slowly, angled from the rail to five-wide on the turn then lacked a strong late response. CROWN RULER, in range, was hustled two-wide on the turn then tired a furlong out. FRONTIER WARRIOR, in range early, saved ground then tired in the stretch. HEAVY STEVE had brief speed, was taken back to stalk the pace, chased to the stretch and tired. UNGIVEN REASON had brief speed, was headed and stalked the pace, tired late turn and faded between foes.
