LIGHT VELVET bumped with a rival at the outset, settled off the pace, circled on the far turn, bid upper stretch, drove clear then just held under a drive. NO COMPRENDE, bumped at the start, settled off the pace, was blocked late turn, angled out at the top of the stretch and rallied fast but missed. EMILY CARR, away slowly, raced off the pace, chased five-wide on the far turn, rallied but evened out in deep stretch. FAITH IN PHOEBE, away slowly, raced off the pace then rallied late between horses. JENNY COME LATELY, in range, chased four-wide into the stretch but did not threaten. MISS ECHO DURING stalked the pace, chased three-wide on the far turn then flattened out in the stretch. BEST OF THE BELLES, in range early, dropped back, was hustled into

the stretch but did not threaten. LEESON STREET LADY stalked the pace, bid late backstretch and led early turn, was passed upper stretch and tired. TIMED PERFECTLY stalked the pace in hand, was hustled hard three-wide on the far turn then flattened out in the stretch. WHITEWATER MIST, in range, chased four-wide on the turn but lacked a closing response. RAGEING BROOKE, off slowly, raced in midpack, was hustled along the rail on the far turn but failed to menace. BIG HOPE set a reserved pace, was headed nearing the far turn, chased to the stretch and tired. HAGGAT HALL, wide on the first turn, settled in midpack, dropped back on the backstretch and trailed.
