WAITINGINTHEWINGS pressed the pace, dueled from early backstretch, drew clear nearing the turn, set the pace then held under a steady drive through the stretch. PECHE MOBILEE, rated in range, chased late turn, lapped on to the leader in the stretch, was determined to the wire but hung. LYNNESSA raced off the pace, chased four-wide late turn, was blocked at the head of the stretch, split foes in the final furlong and rallied belatedly. A BETTER BREEZE, steadied at the start, was in range, was hustled two-wide on the far turn then finished gamely. AWFULLY SINFUL settled off the pace, chased into the stretch then evened out in the late stages. GOOD VIBRATION stalked the pace in hand, chased late turn but flattened out in the final furlong. ZINNIA bobbled at the start, sprinted to the lead and set the pace, dueled from early backstretch, was headed approaching the turn then backed away turn, finished the race and walked off.
