MARISA GO stalked the early pace three wide, drew even at the quarter pole, then shook loose in the final furlong under steady pressure. SHEILA'S PROSPECT pressed the early pace inside of rivals, drew even along the rail on the turn and held place gamely. AMERICAN IN PARIS was unhurried early outside of rivals, ran a little greenly in the drive but finished evenly. ROMAN ROMANCE was void of early speed inside of rivals and rallied belatedly. LIGHTNING PACE was unhurried early, roused four wide on the turn and finished with a mild bid. SLOT HAPPY set a pressured pace in the two path, dueled gamely between horses in the drive, but got tired in the late going and faded. NO CHEATING was void of early speed three wide and never a threat. NORTHBOUND SALLY was unhurried early between horses and never a threat. CAT ON A ROOF was allowed to settle in the three path, then dropped back on the turn.
