BRASS IN POCKET led quickly, set a relaxed pace, quickened late on the final turn and drew off then prevailed under light handling. BAY SWEETIE BABE always in striking range, raced three-wide on the clubhouse turn, was roused two-wide late on the final turn and was all out in the stretch to save the place. ROMAN ROMANCE unhurried early, closed from midway of the far turn and finished determinedly. KISSED BY A PRINCE stalked along the second path, chased on the far turn but flattened out in the stretch. KABUL raced off the pace, moved four-wide into the far turn and was hustled along but lacked a stretch response. LUCKY FERN stalked from the rail, could not stay close on the far turn and faded.
