SWEET BREANNA, in touch three-wide, closed late turn, bid four-wide a furlong out and drove clear. BLONDE WISDOM, in touch between foes, closed along the rail in the stretch. GOLD FISH, unhurried, was hustled four-wide on the turn and rallied from well back in the stretch. RIVER LEE stalked three-wide, bid late turn, dueled upper stretch then weakened. ELKHART forced the issue, bid late turn, led at the top of the stretch but tired. SIMPLY AGAIN raced off the pace, came three-wide through the turn but did not threaten. TEE CUBED, always well off the pace, raced along the second path but never threatened. UNCANNY JUDITH set a pressured pace, tired at the top of the stretch.
