STAKES Kingarvie S. Black Type - Thoroughbred

FOR TWO-YEAR-OLDS, sired by a stallion standing in Ontario for his entire season the year of conception and registered with the Canadian Thoroughbred Horse Society for that season. By subscription of \$125 each which shall accompany the nomination and an additional \$1,250 when making entry. The purse to be divided: 60% to the winner, 20% to second, 11% to third, 6% to fourth and 3% to fifth. Weight 122 lbs. Winners of a sweepstakes of \$75,000 once at a mile or over, additional 2 lbs.; Non-winners of a sweepstakes of \$75,000 twice allowed 3 lbs.; Of a sweepstakes of \$75,000 once, 5 lbs.; Of a race other than claiming, 7 lbs. (No Canadian Bred Allowance.) Final entries to be made through the entry box at the closing time then in effect for overnight events. A supplemental nomination may be made no later than the time of final entry by a non-refundable fee of \$2,500 which includes the entry fee. Plus up to \$8,300 Ontario Sire/Ontario Bred Breeder Awards. \$95,000 of this purse has been provided through the Thoroughbred Improvement Program. Closed Wednesday, November 14, 2007 with 25 nominations. (S)

Footnotes

DELAFORCE stalked from the rail, moved two-wide into the far turn, continued to stalk, angled three-deep at the top of the stretch and drove to the lead with a furlong to run and held under steady handling. LADY'S FIRST CAT, in touch, was hustled hard four-wide on the far turn and finished all out. PROMISING DANCER led early, set a reserved pace, quickened on the turn then gave way grudgingly in the final furlong. BOLD SUSPECT stalked the pace, chased into the stretch, lodged his bid upper stretch then evened out. MAMMA'S KNIGHT, in touch, edged closer late backstretch, lacked a clear path and settled back a bit, tendered an all out challenge upper stretch, could not sustain the bid and and tired.
