Footnotes

SILVER BAG up close and in the hunt into the turn from well off the rail, bid three wide into the stretch then was full out to the wire to prevail late. FIRST ROW CENTER pressed the pace while inside, took on the leader then had a slim lead in the drive but missed late. HOLD THAT ECHO in mid pack, was in the six path and coming on through the stretch but did not have enough to catch the top two. THUNDERUNDERCOVER off a step slow, trailed into the turn then had a belated wide run in the stretch but did not threaten the top three. MISS REGINELLA off the pace and off the rail, did not fire. SKY CAN FLY had a slim lead while under pressure from inside foe from the outset, kept on the engine through the turn then faded. SKY HALO had a rail trip and was in the hunt on the turn then tired.
