A MATTEROFSPEAKING chased the leader while outside that one, kept contact on the turn, did not menace in the drive but was a clear best of the rest. NORTHERN MISS had an outside trip, was widest turning for home then came up with a late move to nail the show spot. ACTION NINE off the pace then in the eight path into the stretch, bid from there but came up short. WISE TRICK settled in mid pack before coming home with a mild inside try. KALAMBAKA QUEEN vied from the rail and was in the hunt into the turn then backed off and faded. GO FOR DAYLIGHT chased the leaders while inside of foes into the turn then had no bid and tired.
