MAMMA'S KNIGHT came from the inside to bid up the rail in the stretch and finished off a good effort behind a romping winner. GUIPAGO made up ground from well back, bid from the five path and was going well late. LADY'S FIRST CAT tracked the leaders and was a factor into the stretch then evened out. SEPTEMBER SQUARE raced in mid pack then failed to fire. COBOTOWN RON rated off the pace and had no rally. SPIRIT LODGE raced well back and then had no rally. J J FOR DAVE trailed early and was never a factor. PETER'S CHARISMA backed away after chasing the leaders into the far turn. PIRATE'S LEGEND was off the pace then failed to bid. KILLDARES PROSPECT showed little and was never in it. QUINZEE vied for the lead then faded on the far turn.
