Footnotes

KAIN'S DEED stalked the pace, closed three-wide on the turn, bid at the 1/4 pole, dueled through the stretch and prevailed under a drive. PASSERINE stalked from the rail, angled out at the top of the stretch and rallied determinedly, challenged a furlong out, dueled to the end but missed. NATIVE PROSPECT was used early to gain command, dueled to the turn and shook clear, was pressured to the 1/4 pole then dueled from there but weakened in deep stretch. REPUTED DEEDS dueled on the backstretch, forced the issue on the turn, rebid at the 1/4 pole, dueled into the stretch and weakened. WAR BEAU dropped back quickly, trailed from the rail, swung out late turn then passed tiring foes. STRIKE THE HARP stalked the pace after an alert beginning, chased four-wide on the turn, drifted wide at the top of the stretch and flattened out. BALDACHINO in touch early from the rail, faded on the turn and lacked a rally. DESERT SOLITAIRE stalked the pace briefly then faded on the turn and lacked a rally.
