L'AVENUE forced the pace, took the lead nearing the far turn, set a pressured pace, shook clear into the stretch and held sway under a drive. CLASSIC MARIA raced in midpack, closed on the far turn, chased three-wide into the stretch and finished gamely. AVERY AMOUR settled off the pace, was hustled four and five-wide through the far turn and finished all out. BURMAH STAR, in midpack early, closed on the backstretch, failed with a bid late turn and chased through the stretch. PEAK CHOICE raced off the pace, was hustled five-wide on the far turn then finished determinedly in vain. REPUTED RUN, in range, chased hard three to five-wide on the far turn but failed to menace. TABANKA stalked the pace, failed with a bid into the far turn, chased to the stretch and tired. SPEND NOW AND SAVE settled off the pace, raced along the second path on the far turn but never reached contention. WHISKEY ROMANCE raced off the pace, was hustled four-wide on the far turn then lacked a rally. SPECIAL MOMENT raced in midpack, chased hard along the rail through the turn then flattened out in the stretch. FUTURE CUPID stumbled at the start, recovered quickly and gained the lead entering the clubhouse turn, set a pressured pace, was headed nearing the far turn and faded quickly.
