HITEC DAVE dueled on the main track, held a short lead into the turn, was engaged midturn, dueled, then prevailed with a strong late effort. VENTURE EXCHANGE led briefly then forced the pace, bid midturn, dueled, then gave way grudgingly in deep stretch. DESTINY'S SONG, in touch, closed four-wide on the turn then finished under a determined drive. JOHNNY LA RUE pressed the pace along the rail, was taken back a bit at the turn, stalked to the stretch then finished gamely. LOCALLY MADE, in range between foes, stalked two-wide on the turn then evened out in the late stages. BET ON JACK dueled on the main track, gave way nearing the turn, was hustled between foes then flattened out in the stretch. NO EXCHANGES settled off the pace, chased on the turn, was roused but had no serious response. SAMURAI SLAM, in range, chased four and five-wide on the turn then evened out in the stretch.
