PAYNES GOLD pressed the pace from between rivals, bid early turn but was turned back, came again upper stretch and again failed to get up but persevered and finally got up at the wire. GREAT IT TIZ set a pressured pace, turned back PAYNES GOLD early on the turn and again upper stretch but failed to contain the winner at the wire. KNIGHT'S QUEST, in range along the rail, was hustled between foes on the turn and was all out through the stretch. HANDY HAROLD, in range four-wide, was hustled on the turn then hung in the late stages. FULL OF WISDOM, in range between rivals, was hustled on the turn then lacked a clear path in the stretch but finished gamely once clear in the late stages. GALILEAN raced off the pace, chased hard four and five-wide on the turn, finished all out but still needed more. PIRATE'S LEGEND pressed the pace three-wide, was rouse don the turn but evened out in the stretch. HARD ICE forced the pace on the backstretch, backed away a bit on the turn, was hustled along then tired in the final furlong.
