Footnotes

FOXY LION stalked the pace, chased three-wide on the turn, bid at the top of the stretch, moved clear and held sway under a drive. LEAVE YOUR MARK, always in range, raced three-deep on the turn, was up close at the top of the stretch and finished gamely. LORD OF GREATNESS was contentious between rivals, moved to the rail late turn but was blocked, lugged in through the stretch and was unable to show his best. STAGWORKS raced off the pace, was hustled four-wide on the turn, loomed up menacingly at the top of the stretch but evened out. LONE ENDEAVOR forced the pace from the rail, bid late turn, vied into the stretch and gave way. DAVERICK set a pressured pace, was engaged late turn and gave way upper stretch. JUNIOR ATTORNEY raced off the pace while well in hand, lost his path along the rail late turn and evened out in the stretch.
