**Footnotes**

ARGUMENT CLOSE raced midpack, closed on the turn, came five-wide into the stretch, bid a furlong out and drove clear. SEEKING THE CODE dueled, gained a short lead on the turn, vied into the stretch and gained a short lead but was engaged a furlong out and yielded. PANTASTIC steadied at the start, raced well back, was hustled two-wide on the turn then finished all out late inside. TETON PASS, close early, chased on the turn, bid four-wide at the top of the stretch, was no match and evened out. JULES CAESAR raced midpack, angled from four to six-wide through the turn, was roused upper stretch but never reached contention. PEEPIN raced midpack, raced from two to four-wide through the turn, chased into the stretch and finished gamely in vain. CANVEY ISLAND had speed between horses, gave away early turn, faded, was hustled into the stretch but lacked a rally. BUDDHA MASTER raced off the pace, was hustled seven-wide late turn but failed to menace. MR. MIELE, in touch early, chased into the turn, was hustled along and was roused late turn but showed no response. FALSE ECONOMY raced off the pace, saved ground but lacked a rally. I FLOATNTHECLOUDS, close early, chased hard on the turn, bid near the 1/4 pole, was headed upper stretch and tired.
