BEAR'S CHILL, in range, took command with a strong move into the turn and drew clear then was all out widening through the stretch. NINE O WONDERFUL raced off the pace, was hustled angling from five to seven-wide on the turn, was in striking range at the top of the stretch, failed to lodge a bid but chased to the end. LITTLE MISTER WOO stalked up close early, chased four and five-wide on the turn then evened out in the late stages. EBERLE, in midpack early, dropped back a little on the turn, chased into the stretch but showed no late gain. C. C. RIDE raced midpack, angled from two to five-wide on the turn then posted a mild late run. NAMATH pressed the pace, failed with a bid into the turn, chased to the stretch and evened out. PLEDGE OF TRUTH raced off the pace, was hustled six-wide on the turn but never reached contention. COCKEYED ROOSTER showed early speed in hand, was joined late backstretch and then headed, chased on the turn then flattened out. OH BOY pressed the pace early, dropped back at the turn and faded gradually between horses.
