GOVERNOR KHALIFA, in range, was hustled five-wide late turn, bid in the final furlong and drove clear. SIR BERRINGER, in range, chased along the rail late turn and rallied gamely. STRIKE OIL raced in midpack, chased four-wide into the stretch and finished determinedly. SHACKLETON HILL dueled, edged ahead midway of the backstretch, set the pace, was passed near midstretch and tired. SALUTING STORMYE settled off the pace, was hustled angling out five-wide late turn and rallied gamely. FRIDAY NIGHT GUY pressed the pace, chased hard on the turn then evened out in the late stages. OROCOMO raced in midpack, was hustled four and five-wide on the turn then evened out in deep stretch. ROCKIN ON TOP showed speed then forced the pace into the turn, chased to the stretch and tired. WOOKINWICKED raced off the pace, was hustled late backstretch, chased six-wide late turn but was never a threat. BRITE SAMMY raced in midpack, chased late turn but did not threaten. PLEASURE PEAKS settled in midpack, checked behind a fading rival late turn and did not threaten. ONE THOUSAND PLUS pressed the pace, chased to midturn and gave way. LOUIS showed brief speed, gave way midway of the backstretch, stayed in range to late turn and tired. DUENDECILLO was always outrun.
