**Footnotes**

LOST THE RING pressed the pace, bid early turn, dueled, shook clear upper stretch and held sway under a hand ride. BEARS MIRACLE stalked the pace, chased five-wide into the stretch, was under an all out drive and was gaining late. GALLIPOLI settled off the pace, closed angling from four to seven-wide late turn but failed to menace. NORTHERN MONARCH raced off the pace, was hustled on the turn but6 never reached contention. BOLT WEST held a short early lead, dueled on the turn, was headed at the top of the stretch and tired. U HUSH stalked the pace, chased two and three-wide on the turn then flattened out in the stretch. SIN OF OMISSION forced the pace, bid along the rail late backstretch, gave way early turn, chased to the stretch and tired. HAMEISH raced off the pace, saved ground, was hustled along but lacked a stretch response. REGGAETON DANCER raced off the pace, came five-wide through the turn, chased into the stretch but lacked a rally. FOREST FOUNTAIN, in range early, faded on the turn. PERIGEE SILENCE was prominent early between rivals but faded from early turn.
