**Footnotes**

HENKE settled in midpack, closed late backstretch, bid midturn, dueled, shook clear upper stretch, was headed in the late stages but came again and nailed it on the wire. EXECUTIVE BARLEE raced in midpack, chased on the far turn, rallied, bid in deep stretch. gained a narrow lead but was outfinished. A. A. GRENADE settled off the pace, closed on the far turn, was up close early stretch but did not get off a bid and evened out. LOOK NO MORE stalked the pace, bid midturn, dueled, yielded upper stretch and flattened out. BRAVE SKY assumed the early lead, set a reserved pace, was engaged midturn and gave way. MASTER EXECUTIVE, unhurried early, was hustled on the far turn but lacked a closing response.
