Footnotes

FRENCH QUARTER showed brief speed and was headed, forced the pace, bid at the top of the stretch, dueled, then drove clear in the late stages. CRUSHED broke outward, took a short lead midway of the backstretch, set a pressured pace, was engaged at the top of the stretch, dueled to deep stretch and yielded. FOREIGN ACCENT stalked the pace, chased four-wide into the stretch, finished gamely and was gaining late. SEEKING THE BAY settled in midpack, came four to six-wide through the turn, chased into the stretch and rallied mildly. MARGIN CALL broke outward, stalked the pace, chased late turn but evened out in the final furlong. ENDURABLE, bothered at the start, raced in midpack, chased three to five-wide through the turn then flattened out in the final furlong. SHOTGUN ROMEO, bothered at the start, settled off the pace, chased on the turn but never reached contention. IMPERATORE dropped well off the pace, was hustled on the turn but lacked a closing response.
