SWEET BREANNA bobbed at the start, quickly took command, set a pressured early pace, quickened on the far turn then held RIVERADA safe under a drive. RIVERADA stalked from the rail, chased from the second path on the far turn then finished determinedly. UNTOUCHED was unhurried early, circled three-wide on the far turn but never reached contention. CLASSICAL MISS stalked the pace, was hustled along the second-path through the far turn then flattened out. PARRSBORO GOLD raced off the pace, closed along the rail on the far turn but did not threaten. NATIVE WISDOM, five-wide on the first turn, remained in touch from the outside then faded on the far turn. RUNNING CLEAR stalked the pace from between foes but faded three-wide late backstretch. THROUGH THICKNTHIN forced the pace in the early going, chased on the backstretch but gave way nearing the far turn and faded.
