MISS FUHR was hustled to the lead into the first turn, set a reserved pace then held under steady pressure. WEST END LADY stalked the pace, chased on the far turn and was all out in the stretch. BOTTOM CLOSE, well back early, was roused three-wide on the far turn, closed to the stretch then evened out. VALENTINE'S MIST, close early, settled, was hustled through the far turn but flattened out. XTRA DASH trailed to the far turn, was hustled through the turn, never reached contention. DANCING SPIRIT saved ground, was set down on the far turn but did not threaten. MA PECHE, in touch to the backstretch, faded steadily. KIRISTENA had speed from the gate, stalked the pace then faded late backstretch.
