Footnotes

SWIFTNASSY, hustled early, stalked the pace, bid early turn, shook clear late turn and widened under steady handling. BELLA RUSH, in touch, was hustled four-wide on the turn and was all out in the stretch. DIXIETWOSTEPPEP raced off the pace, was roused along the rail on the turn but hung in the stretch. THE PREETZAH, well back early, was hustled on the turn but never reached contention. COUSIN SALLY stalked three-wide then flattened out in the stretch. ELEFThERIA raced midpack, was hustled five-wide on the turn then evened out. SASSY STAR dwelt briefly, raced well back along the rail, lacked a rally. RARE PARADIS led quickly, set the pace to the turn, was engaged early turn, yielded, and tired.
