CHARLIES MIST pressed the pace, chased hard late turn, bid upper stretch and drove clear then held under steady pressure. SILENT STREAK settled in midpack, chased on the turn and was all out through the stretch. MARATHON RUN stalked the pace in hand, angled off the rail upper stretch and chased gamely to the end. SYNERGIST raced off the pace, chased four-wide late turn and finished determinedly. BEHIND THE TIMES, rated off the pace, chased four-wide late turn but never reached contention. EILDON HALL settled off the pace, chased two-wide on the turn then evened out in the final 16th. TAKE A GAMBLE set a reserved pace, was passed a furlong out and tired. KELLOWAY, off badly, trailed the field, chased on the turn and passed a tiring rival. WHITEWATER MIST raced off the pace, was hustled four and five-wide on the turn then tired at the top of the stretch.
