BIGSTORBREWIN' led quickly in hand, set the pace, was pressured on the turn, shook clear into the stretch then held under a drive. RUN TO THE BANK, in range, forced the pace on the turn, chased into the stretch then finished under a determined drive. JOHNNY LA RUE raced off the pace, closed into the turn, chased to the stretch and finished gamely. TEVEZ, bumped at the start, moved to the rail quickly, raced in midpack, angled out from midturn then finished gamely in vain. COURTVILLE came in and bumped a rival at the start, settled off the pace, was hustled along the rail on the turn but never reached contention. GENTLEMAN JACKSON stalked the pace, chased from the rail on the turn then flattened out in the stretch. TOP PROSPECT raced in midpack, was hustled four-wide on the turn then lacked a closing response. AWESOME ECLIPSE raced in midpack, chased on the turn then flattened out in the stretch.
