TIMARK, unhurried early, closed on the far turn, took the lead in the final furlong and held under a drive. O WANDERLUST raced off the pace, bid four-wide into the far turn, dueled, chased into the stretch and finished all out. DOCTOR LUKE broke outward, raced off the pace, bid along the rail into the far turn, dueled, had command upper stretch but failed to stay in the late stages. QUEENSBURY RULES settled off the pace, closed on the far turn, chased hard into the stretch and evened out late. B VEXED, off slowly, raced well back, chased hard on the far turn then flattened out in the stretch. RESAMA raced off the pace, was hustled through the far turn then flattened out in the stretch. ASCOT'S BREEZE stumbled at the start, trailed the field and wound up passing the tired front runner. THE MIGHTY SPARROW sprinted to a long lead, came back to the field nearing the far turn and was through.
