SHIRLEY MARY N FLO stalked the pace, chased three-wide late turn, bid a furlong out and drove clear. SPLASH OF GOLD led early, set the pace but failed to stave off the winner in the final furlong. PLAY MIZZTY FOR ME, in touch, closed four-wide late turn then evened out. PURE MALT prompted the pace, chased on the turn, launched a bid but failed to get up and evened out in the stretch. OCALA SKY broke alertly, settled midpack, raced three-wide, lacked a rally. POETIC FAN raced off the pace, was hustled three-wide late turn then hung in the stretch. LASTCHANCECHITTER trailed, angled out late turn but never threatened. MAJESTIC STRIKE was hustled along the rail, lacked a rally. RAINY PRINCESS stalked the early pace then faded between horses.
