### Footnotes

ROYAL DISTRACTION vied inside CELESTIALBUTTERFLY, edged clear midbackstretch, was engaged late turn and was headed at the top of the stretch but battled back and drew clear late. FAR AND NEAR stalked the pace, chased three-wide on the far turn, bid near the 1/4 pole and took command at the top of the stretch but failed to hold in the late stages. PHEISTY PHOEBE stalked the pace then lacked a closing response. BAISER D'AMOUR, well back early, closed four-wide late turn and finished willingly in vain. MA PECHE stalked the pace three-wide on the first turn, saved ground through the far turn but showed no late response. CELESTIALBUTTERFLY dueled, chased on the far turn then tired in the stretch. WAR BEAU, well back early, raced on the second path and lacked a rally. NYKEE, always far back, lacked a late response. GRACEFUL GAL saved ground but was through early.
