DELIGHTED SEASON stalked the pace, bid late turn, drove clear upper stretch and held sway under steady handling. ACEUPPHILSLEEVE stalked the pace, bid late turn, was outkicked and chased all out through the stretch. LIAM AND ALEX settled in midpack, was hustled two-wide on the turn and finished gamely. WIDE RIGHT, away slowly, settled off the pace, saved ground on the far turn then rallied along the rail. SUE THEM ALL settled off the pace, was hustled four to six-wide on the far turn but never reached contention. OSCULATOR broke outward and settled well back early, was hustled on the far turn and rallied belatedly. COMPADRE'S TIME settled well off the pace, was hustled two-wide on the far turn then gamely in vain. BISU settled off the pace, was hustled on the far turn, chased five-wide into the stretch and finished gamely outside. BORJOMI raced in midpack, chased on the far turn then flattened out in the late stages. ROCKIN HEAT set a reserved pace, was caught late on the far turn and tired at the top of the stretch. BEAR'S ACCOUNTANT, in range

early, chased on the far turn but tired in the stretch. SLEW THE MAESTRO, always well back, lacked a rally.
